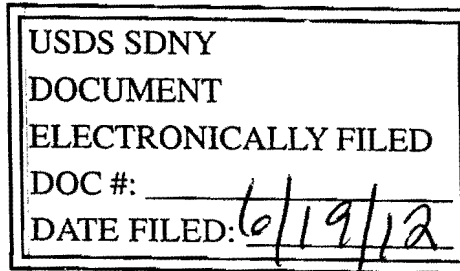

Dear Judge Baer:


We represent defendants LimeWire LLC, Lime Group LLC and Mark Gorton ("Defendants") in the above-captioned action. Based on discussions with counsel for plaintiffs, the parties jointly request that the Court refer this case to the Honorable John F. Keenan to conduct a one day mediation in order to determine whether a prompt settlement can be reached by the parties.

By way of background, LimeWire's file-trading service at issue in this action has been the subject of several prior litigations within this District. *See Arista Records LLC v. Lime Group LLC*, 715 F.Supp.2d 481 (S.D.N.Y. 2010). During the damages trial in *Arista Records*, Judge Wood referred the case to Judge Keenan for a mediation that resulted in a settlement. In a subsequent case, *Merlin BV v. Lime Wire LLC, et al.* No. 11 CV 4822 (KMW), Judge Keenan also held a mediation between the parties that resulted in a settlement. Based on these prior mediations, Judge Keenan has gained significant familiarity with the issues in dispute, and the parties believe such experience would substantially increase the prospects of resolving this case. If Judge Keenan is unavailable to serve as a mediator, the parties will accept any other Judicial Officer that Your Honor deems appropriate.

Lastly, attached to this letter is a copy of a Stipulation and Proposed Order extending Defendants' time to answer or otherwise respond to the Complaint while mediation is pending, which has been submitted to the orders and judgment clerk. The parties respectfully request that the Court so-order the enclosed stipulation.


