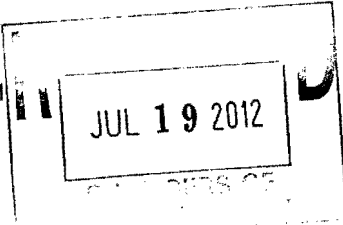

Dear Magistrate Judge Peck:

I represent Defendant Publicis Groupe S.A. ("Publicis") in the above-referenced matter. Pursuant to your Honor's rulings during the July 9, 2012 status conference, jurisdictional discovery is scheduled to close on July 30, 2012, and Plaintiffs' response in opposition to Publicis' Motion for Summary Judgment for Lack of Personal Jurisdiction is due no later than August 13, 2012. (Hr'g Tr. at 35:9-15.)

During the July 9 status conference, your Honor also ruled that Plaintiffs may take a third party deposition of Re:Sources USA. I have been retained by Re:Sources USA to defend this deposition and have been authorized to accept service of a subpoena on its behalf. I have conferred with Plaintiffs' counsel and counsel for MSLGroup regarding scheduling. Due to witness and attorney availability, the first date on which we are available for that deposition is July 31. Accordingly, the parties jointly request a one-day extension of the jurisdictional discovery deadlines set during the July 9 status conference. The proposed discovery and briefing schedule for jurisdictional discovery would now include the following deadlines:

- Jurisdictional Discovery Deadline: July 31, 2012
- Deadline for Plaintiffs' Opposition: August 14, 2012
- Deadline for Publicis' Reply: August 21, 2012
