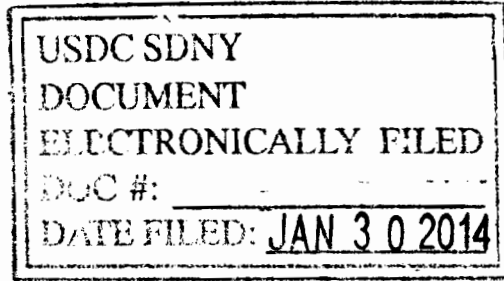

ORDER

The Court has thoroughly reviewed the parties' submissions in response to its December 19, 2013 Order to Show Cause as to why this case should not be stayed pending the issuance of the decision of the Supreme Court of the United States in Halliburton Co. v. Erica P. John Fund, Inc., No. 13-317, 2013 WL 4858670 (U.S. Nov. 15, 2013). The Court finds that the interests of justice and judicial efficiency counsel the stay of the proceedings in this case. Therefore, proceedings in this case are hereby stayed pending a decision in Halliburton.

The parties are directed to submit letters to the Court setting forth their positions on the implications for this case of the Supreme Court's decision in Halliburton within 21 days of the issuance of that decision.
